www.chicoseniorsoftball.com is our website. This is our method of getting information out to the entire organization. It will have schedules, standings, etc. We will also provide general information as needed.

Playing rules, Code of Conduct, board members, commissioners, rosters, and team managers can be accessed on the league website. This is a major improvement that we have made so that you can stay updated as to goings on with our Club.

Registration: Please go to www.chicoseniorsoftball.com to fill out the online application. You will be able to pay by credit card, debit card, or check. If you do not have computer access, then please call any board member and an application will be mailed to you. The fee is \$90 for the season if paid by the draft; after the draft, the fee goes up to \$100. You MUST pay to play. The dates for the draft are: March 12 (Open), March 13 (Veterans), and March 14 (Masters). We are redrafting in all 3 divisions this season and we will only draft those whose applications AND fees are received by draft date. Players whose applications are received after the draft will be placed on teams or on a waiting list by the order of the draft.

The 3 divisions are: Open (ages 48 and over), Veterans (ages 58 and over), and Masters (ages 65 and over). We will assume you want to play in your age and ability appropriate division unless you indicate to us on the application form of a change. It is still up to the Board of Directors to approve all changes. You also need to indicate if you plan on playing in more than one division and pay an extra \$45.

REMEMBER – You must have your application in by March 12, 13, or 14 to be eligible for the draft.

Please register as early as possible. Early registration allows us to better gauge how many teams need to be formed, whether there will have to be a limit to team size, and if players need to be moved to age appropriate divisions.

After the draft, team managers will contact you about your team assignments and/or you can look it up on our website: www.chicoseniorsoftball.com.

Practices are scheduled for Monday through Thursday starting Monday February 26th until league play begins from 4:00pm till dark at **Sycamore Field**. Practices may also be scheduled Saturdays at **Sycamore** from 8am to 12 noon.
